Peace of God. FRFR

- Psalm 125:1-2. Those who trust in the Lord are as unshakeable, as unmovable as mighty Mount Zion! 2 Just as the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord's **wrap-around presence** surrounds his people, protecting them now and forever.
- Psalm 16:8. Because you are close to me and always available, **my confidence will never be shaken, for I experience your wrap-around presence every moment.**
- Psalm 32:8, God speaking. I will stay close to you, instructing and guiding you along the pathway for your life. I will advise you along the way and lead you forth with my eyes as your guide.

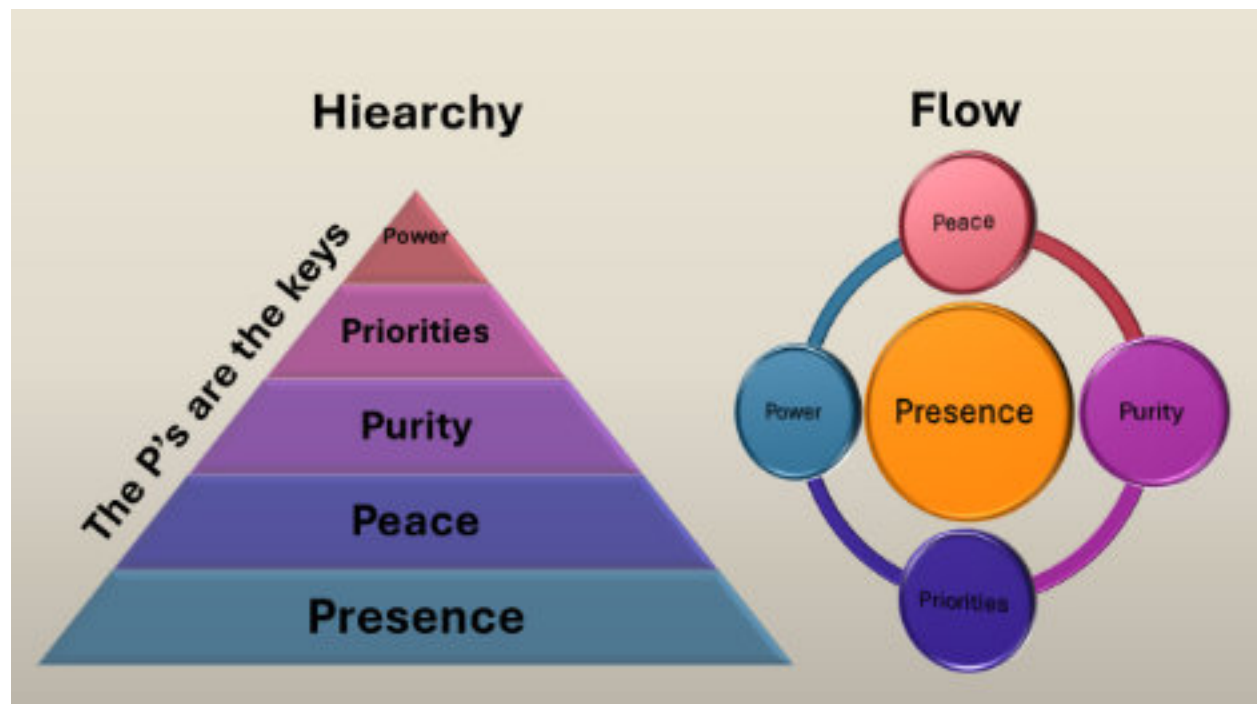
Peace of God. FRFR

- Philippians 4:6-7. Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. Tell him every detail of your life, 7 then **God's wonderful peace** that transcends human understanding, will make the answers known to you through Jesus Christ.

[Greek: guard your heart and your mind in Christ Jesus.]

Peace of God. FRFR

- 2nd Timothy 1:7. For God will never give you the spirit of fear, but the Holy Spirit who gives you mighty power, love, and self-control [revelation-light; instruction].
- Colossians 3:15. Let your heart be always guided by the **peace of the Anointed One, who called you to peace as part of his one body**. And always be thankful.
- Romans 15:13. Now may God, the inspiration and fountain of hope, fill you to overflowing with uncontainable joy and **perfect peace** as you trust in him. And may the **power of the Holy Spirit** continually surround your life with his super-abundance until you radiate with hope!

John 14:27, Jesus speaking, on the very night he'll be betrayed.
Context: teaching about Holy Spirit

"I leave the gift of peace with you—my peace.
Not the kind of fragile peace given by the world, but
my perfect peace. Don't yield to fear or be
troubled in your hearts—instead, be courageous!"

(Echoes, fulfills Deuteronomy 31:8; Joshua 1:8–9; 10:25. God really means this!)

John 16:33, Jesus speaking, on the very night he'll be betrayed.
Context: teaching about Holy Spirit

And everything I've taught you is so that the
peace which is in me will be in you
and will give you great confidence as you rest in me.
For in this unbelieving world you will experience
trouble and sorrows, but you must be courageous, for
I have conquered the world!"

*Jesus has taken away the power this world has to defeat us and has conquered it for us. Peace **is** resting in his victory.*

Table Time

Receive Peace. Go in peace

1. **Engage** the video fully;
2. **Ask Holy Spirit & discuss ideas:** What is one thing we could do this week to receive Christ's peace more, and live from it more truly and fully?
3. **Encourage, challenge, pray, declare, prophesy** over one another to purposefully do one or more of those this week;
4. **Declare aloud together** over one another: "Now, may the Lord himself, the Lord of peace, pour into you his peace in every circumstance and in every possible way. The Lord's tangible presence be with you!"

(2nd Thessalonians 3:16)
