Who and what are we evangelizing?

## 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 10:23

- ESV. “All things are lawful,” but not all things are helpful. “All things are lawful,” but not all things build up.
- NIV. I have the right to do anything,” you say—but not everything is beneficial. “I have the right to do anything”—but not everything is constructive.
- TPT. You say, “Under grace there are no rules and we’re free to do anything we please.” Not exactly. Because not everything promotes growth in others. Your slogan, “We’re allowed to do anything we choose,” may be true—but not everything causes the spiritual advancement of others.

## Romans 8:28

- **ESV. *And*** we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.
- **NIV. *And*** we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- **TPT. *So*** we are convinced that every detail of our lives is continually woven together for good, for we are his lovers who have been called to fulfill his designed purpose.

1. **Discuss: Do you view Halloween differently now? If so, why and how? If not, why not?**
2. **Read 1<sup>st</sup> John 4:18 (below). In what ways could this be put into practice during Halloween season this year and/or following years?**

ESV. There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.

NIV. There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

TPT. Love never brings fear, for fear is always related to punishment. But love's perfection drives the fear of punishment far from our hearts. Whoever walks constantly afraid of punishment has not reached love's perfection.
